## MOTI Open House—June 24, 2015 | 4:00—6:00 pm @ Prestige



Minister Todd Stone has confirmed an Open House has been scheduled to share MOTI plans for the west-end TransCanada Highway development in Salmon Arm.

## June 16th Presentation—Hon. Todd Stone, Minister of Transportation



The Chamber was very pleased to host a presentation by the Honourable Todd Stone, Minister of Transportation on Tuesday, June 16th. Minister Stone shared their BC On the Move—10 Year Plan results in addition to the Ministry's plans for investment and rehabilitation of our existing infrastructure. They have taken a multi-pronged approach to the next decade which includes economic development and partnerships as part of the overall strategy.

\$18M of the total investment is planned for a cycle tour program incorporating improved or new cycle paths, shoulder widening & maintenance as well as signage and marketing.

For the Salmon Arm area, Min. Stone spoke to the 4-laning projects west of Salmon Arm, replacement of the Salmon Arm bridge and announced June 24th as the MOTI Open House date for unveiling the current TCH development plans for the west-side of Salmon Arm.

Trucking strategies are also in the work with increased CVSE coverage already taking place. Additional truck pull-outs and rest areas are also being developed to ensure additional opportunities for chain hook-up, etc. A variable speed program with sensed roadways and electronic speed signs (for speed changes due to road conditions) are expected for 2016. The 50 participants at the presentation also had an opportunity to ask Min. Stone a variety of questions.
